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The Richlands Police Department is currently hiring for the position of Police Officer. [Applications](#) can be picked up and submitted at Town Hall along with a notarized copy of the Law Enforcement Training and Standards [F-3 form](#), Monday thru Thursday, 0800-1700 and Friday 0800-1200. **(only BLET Certified individuals need apply at this time).**

Applicants for the position of Police Officer with the Richlands Police Department must:

- Be 20 years of age or older upon date of employment
- Pass a medical examination
- Be a Citizen of the United States
- Be a high school graduate or possess an equivalency certificate
- Possess a valid North Carolina driver's license
- Have no convictions of a felony or serious misdemeanor
- Submit to a thorough background investigation Position

Benefits

- Retirement:
 - Law Enforcement Officers Retirement System (LEORS): You qualify for full (or unreduced) retirement benefits at age 55 and complete five years of creditable service as an officer, or 30 years of service, at any age.
 - Special Separation Allowance: Provides an annual benefit equal to 0.85% times the years of service times the final base annual salary of the employee, payable from the date of retirement until age 62.
- Insurance: • Medical, dental, vision, and life insurance provided at no cost to the employee. Family plans are available at an additional cost.
- Other Benefits:
 - Uniforms and Equipment
 - Paid Holidays
 - Vacation/Sick Leave
 - Workers' Compensation
 - Competitive Salaries
 - Take Home Car Program within defined area
