- Newspaper
- Cereal Boxes
- Magazines
- Junk Mail
- Telephone Books
- Green, Brown & Clear Glass
- Corrugated Cardboard
- Gable-Top Cartons (Milk Cartons)
- Empty Aerosol Cans
- Aluminum Beverage Cans
- Aluminum, Steel & Tin Food Cans
- Aluminum Foils
- Plastics # 1 – 7
- Rigid Plastics (Buckets, Plastic Toys, Lawn Furniture) Mixed rigid plastics must be under 2 feet in length and under 40 pounds

Unacceptable Material

- Bagging Material
- Mirrors, Windows or Auto Glass
- Light Bulbs
- Ceramics
- Antifreeze containers
- Coat Hangers
- Paint Cans
- Hard Cover Books
- Plastic Clam Shells
- PVC pipe/tubing
- Vinyl Siding
- Styrofoam or Polystyrene
- Plastic Medical Waste
- Plastics that have come into contact with Petroleum Products and/or hazardous waster
- Household Items (toasters, cooking pots or pans, etc.)
